# INFANT BAPTISM

## **MINISTER**

In this service we have come to give thanks to God with [*parents names*] for the gift of [*child's name*], to ask God's blessing on him/her and to dedicate ourselves to the responsible task of Christian nurture.

## **BIBLE READINGS**

[Deut. 6:4-7] Hear Israel, the Lord our God is one Lord, and you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul and might. And these words which I command you today, shall be upon your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children.

[Mark 10] They brought children for Jesus to touch. The disciples rebuked them, but when Jesus saw this he was indignant and said to them, 'Let the children come to me; do not try to stop them, for the Kingdom of God belongs to such as these. I tell you, whoever does not accept the Kingdom of God like a child will never enter it.' Then Jesus put his arms around the children, laid his hands on them and blessed them.

[Matthew 28] Jesus said, 'I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. Go then, to all people everywhere and make them my disciples; baptise them in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, and teach them to obey everything I have commanded you.'
